The Qualified Water Efficient Landscaper (QWEL) training is an EPA WaterSense labeled Professional Certification Program for **Irrigation System Audits**. The course provides landscape professionals with hands-on demonstrations and education on proper plant selection, landscape water use, irrigation system design and maintenance, controller programming and operation, and sustainable landscaping.

QWEL graduates are certified to perform 3rd party irrigation audits as specified by Aspen’s Water Efficient Landscaping Standards and will be **listed for hire** on the EPA WaterSense, QWEL, and the City of Aspen websites.

To pass the QWEL course participants must:

- ✓ Attend all 3 days of the training
- ✓ Complete an irrigation audit
- ✓ Pass the QWEL Exam
