



City of Aspen Utilities provides incentive to upgrade to high efficiency heat pump

City of Aspen Utilities, in partnership with its wholesale electric power supplier, provides financial incentives to upgrade to a high efficiency heat pump. With the fall and winter months approaching, now may be a good time to consider upgrading your home heating/cooling unit.

The High Efficiency Heat Pump Program, provided through City of Aspen Utilities and the Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska, provides cash incentives ranging from \$400 to \$3,000 to residential homeowners depending on the type new heat pump installed.

The program is among a suite of five energy efficiency programs offered through City of Aspen Utilities. Each program provides cash incentives for homeowners to make energy efficiency upgrades. The other programs include:

Attic Insulation Program

Provides cash incentives of \$.015/square foot with a maximum incentive of \$300 per existing residential dwelling.

Smart Thermostat Program

Provides a cash incentive of up to \$100 paid directly to residential customers to help cover the cost of installing a qualifying smart thermostat.

Cooling System Tune-Up Program

Provides a \$30 cash incentive to residential homeowners who have their cooling system tuned up by a HVAC contractor, regardless of what type or age of cooling system (air conditioner/air or water source heat pump).

Commercial LED Lighting Program

Provides cash incentives paid directly to commercial customers to help cover the cost of lighting upgrades and replacements.
