FREE SKIER SHUTTLES



Free & frequent shuttles serve Aspen Mountain, Aspen Highlands, Buttermilk and Snowmass ski areas. Parking is limited at all area ski mountains. For current routes and schedules, check with your concierge or call 970.925.8484.

ON DEMAND RIDE SERVICE



Operates 8AM – 11PM

Provides FREE door-to-door service around Aspen. See map to review service area boundaries.

BRUSH CREEK PARK & RIDE



PARK FOR FREE at the Brush Creek Park & Ride lot, then catch a FREE shuttle to Snowmass or Rubey Park Transit Center in downtown Aspen.

CARPOOL permits are available from the Carpool kiosk
Monday – Friday 6AM – Noon

TRAILS & PATHS

The Roaring Fork Valley is home to the Rio Grande Trail, a 44 mile stretch of scenic trail between Aspen and Glenwood Springs. Aspen's trail system is available year-round for hikers, cyclists and nordic skiers.

PARKING OPTIONS

Street Parking

DOWNTOWN PARKING

Parking rates vary by season and hour of day. Parking is enforced 10:00AM–5:59PM

- FREE 15-minute parking available via PayByPhone (maximum one/day)
- FREE between 6PM–2:59AM and 7AM–9:59AM (no parking 3-7AM to allow for street cleaning & snow plow)
- FREE Sundays & Holidays (see website for qualifying days)

RESIDENTIAL PARKING

Zones are just outside of the downtown core, offering a convenient parking value.

- First 2 hours are FREE
- FREE between 5PM–9:59AM (watch signs for exclusions)
- FREE Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays (see website for qualifying days)

Parking Garage

The Rio Grande Parking Garage is located off Mill, north of Main Street. Provides all day covered parking that can be purchased by the hour or day.

- Discounted passes are also available
- FREE 30 minutes in Garage
- FREE between 5PM–5AM daily
- FREE Sundays & Holidays (see website for qualifying days)

Park & Ride

Brush Creek Park & Ride is located at the intersection of Hwy 82 & Brush Creek Road.

- Park for FREE in the Brush Creek Park & Ride lot and catch FREE buses to Snowmass and Rubey Park Transit Center in downtown Aspen

GETTING TO THE AIRPORT

Taxi and limousine services greet every flight at the Aspen/Pitkin County Airport. Many lodges provide courtesy van service to or from the airport and around town. Free RFTA buses also travel between Aspen and the airport.

FROM DENVER, GRAND JUNCTION OR EAGLE COUNTY AIRPORTS

A variety of private transportation providers offer airport services. Amtrak and Bustang services also travel to/from Glenwood Springs, with RFTA bus connections to Aspen.

Transit & Shuttles

Free & frequent transit service is available in Aspen, serving local attractions as well as the airport. Service areas include Aspen Mountain, Aspen Highlands, Buttermilk and Snowmass ski areas. Shuttles depart from the **Rubey Park Transit Center**, located on Durant Avenue, across from the Silver Circle Ice Arena. **All bus service between Aspen and Snowmass Village is free.** Bus service to other communities is available for a fare. **Discounted Value Cards** are available at Rubey Park Transit Center, eliminating the need to carry correct change.

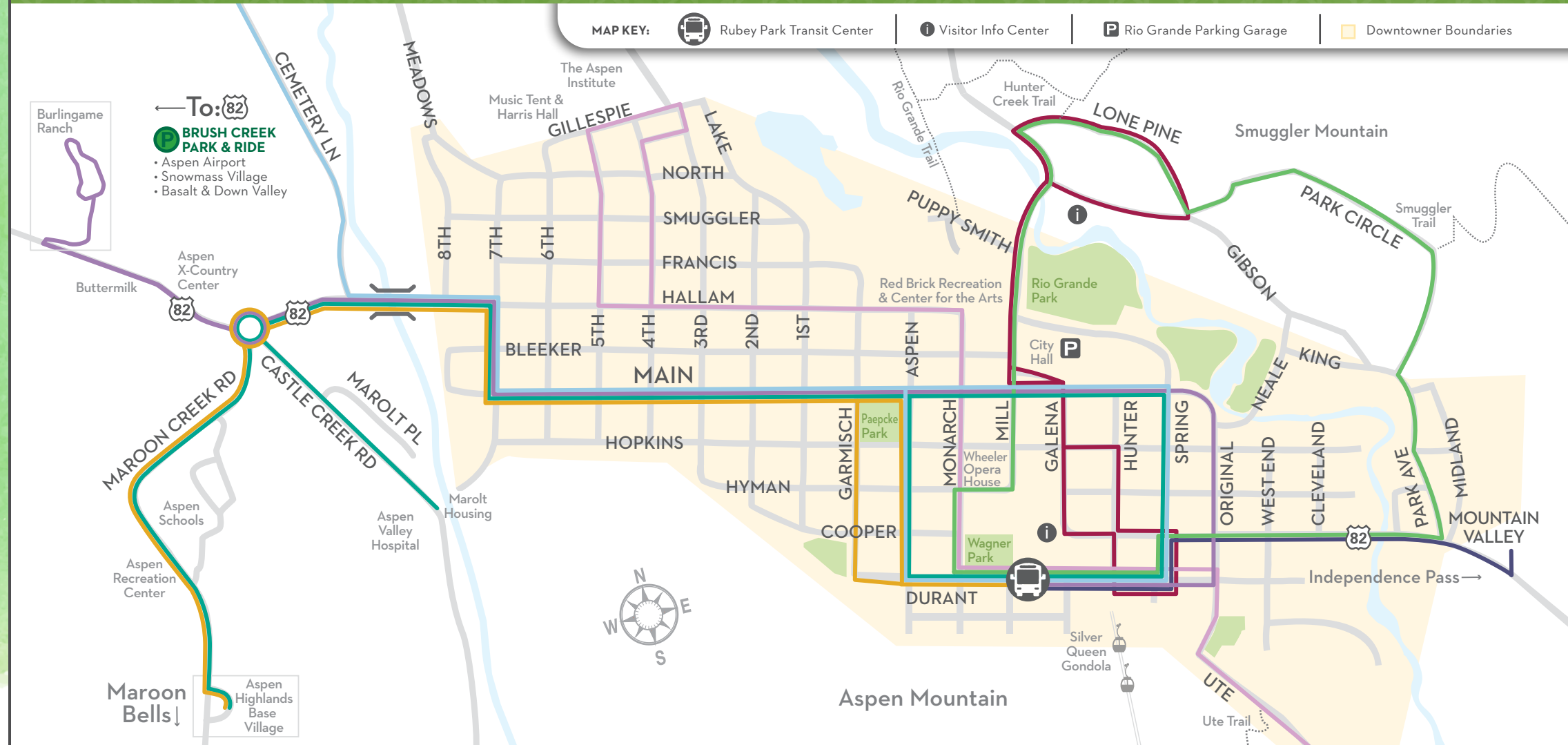

FREE & FREQUENT ASPEN SHUTTLES

(The routes described are FREE unless otherwise noted.)



BG BURLINGAME/HWY 82

Provides service from Rubey Park to the Burlingame Ranch housing complex via Hwy 82. This route is a convenient option for reaching the Aspen X-Country Center or Buttermilk Mountain.

CM CASTLE/MAROON

Provides service from Aspen to Maroon Creek Road and Castle Creek Road serving Aspen Valley Hospital, Aspen Highlands Village and the Aspen Recreation Center.

CL CEMETERY LANE

Travels from Rubey Park to the Cemetery Lane residential area.

XT CROSS TOWN (Winter & Summer Only)

Serves the West End and Ute Avenue neighborhoods including attractions such as the Aspen Institute.

GS GALENA STREET (Winter Only)

Provides continuous service between the Rio Grande Parking Garage and Silver Queen Gondola on Aspen Mountain. Also serving the Hunter Creek neighborhood.

AH HIGHLANDS DIRECT (Winter Only)

Provides service from Rubey Park to Aspen Highlands Village, the Aspen Recreation Center and Aspen schools via Maroon Creek Road.

HC HUNTER CREEK

Serves the residential area of Hunter Creek, providing access to grocery shopping and Aspen's Post Office. Also travels near the popular Smuggler Mountain trail.

MV MOUNTAIN VALLEY DIAL-A-RIDE

Serves the Mountain Valley residential area on a fixed route free of charge. Provides door-to-door service in this area for \$1. Call 970.920.9999 to schedule personalized service.
