



Fence Permit Application Checklist

Note: This is a general list of required information. More information may be required as each project is individually evaluated. When such a request is made, the application can progress only after the necessary information is received. For additional information on fences, please reference our [Municipal Code: Chapter 26.575. MISCELLANEOUS SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS](#)

- Improvement Survey with the original wet stamp and original signature of the surveyor. The survey must include:
 - Topography at 2' contour intervals
 - All easements and rights-of-way
 - Site vicinity map
 - All existing structures and improvements
 - Locations of all trees, trunk diameters (measured 4.5' above grade), and species^I
 - Copy of the survey with the proposed fence delineated^{II}
- Elevation drawings of a fence section showing design, dimensions, and materials
- Homeowner Association Compliance form (found within the Documents and Resource Library on our website)

^I If tree root zone may be impacted, Parks Department approval and a permit are required.

^{II} Do not delineate the proposed fence on the original surveys.
