

STOP DO YOU NEED TO APPLY FOR A TREE PERMIT?



The term "tree" (Sec. 13.20.020(a)) shall include:

- Native tree species 3" DBH and greater
- Deciduous trees 6" DBH and greater
- Evergreen (coniferous) trees 4" DBH and greater

Tree Permit Checklist:

What requires a tree permit?

- Removing trees
- Excavation for construction work near trees
- Any risk of soil disturbance or compaction near trees
- Any work within the dripline of trees
- Municipal Code (Sec. 13.20.020)

When should you apply for a tree permit?

- ASAP – trees need to be evaluated early in the design process!
- Have you spoken to Parks Department and/or the City Forester?
- Tree preservation should be considered during conceptual design!
